Tongji Team Got a Success in ASCE 2013 Mid-Pacific Student Conference



From April 18th to 20th, ASCE 2013 Mid-Pacific Student Conference was held in San Jose State University, California, America. Tongji team got a success in the conference.

The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) was founded in 1852 with a history of more than 150 years. CCE of Tongji applied for the membership of ASCE-International Student Group (ASCE-ISG) from 2008, and finally became its formal member in Dec. 2010. In the year 2012, Tongji students joined the ASCE 2013 Mid-Pacific Student Conference for the first time.

The Team Tongji in this year, formally founded on Nov. 6th, 2012, was composed by 26 undergraduate students from CCE (chiefly), College of Environmental Science and Engineering, College of Material Science and Engineering and College of Mechanical and Energy Engineering. During the 5 months of preparation, these students worked hard and creatively as a team. From April 18th to 20th, 2013, they overcame the adverse conditions and competed with students from UC Berkeley, UC Davis and so on. Their solid professional knowledge, broad vision and excellent communication skill won high reputation among American teachers and students.

In this conference, Team Tongji joined all the competition events and won the first place in Paper Competition, first place in Optimum Stiffness of Steel Bridge, third place in Structure Efficiency of Steel Bridge, first place in Hydrographic Environment Paper Competition, third place in Hydrographic Environment Report Competition, second place in Transportation Competition and also got one first place and two third place in five Mini Games. Among these, it was the first time for Concrete Canoe Group of Team Tongji to join the competition after one and a half years of preparation. The canoe, made in Tongji, was 6 meters long and 15mm thick. It got the sixth place in total scores of Concrete Canoe Competition.
