2014 Professor Meeting Held in CCE





On March 9th, 2014, College of Civil Engineering (CCE) 2014 Professor meeting was held in Jiren Building on Jiading Campus. More than fourty professors from CCE attended the conference. Professor Xiang Haifan, member of Chinese Academy of Engineering and Consultant Dean of CCE, and Professor Chen Yiyi, Vice President of Tongji University also attended the meeting. The topics of this conference focus on three themes, namely the Centennial Celebration of CCE, the Discipline Construction and Student Cultivation, as well as the Pilot College, which were hosted respectively by Prof. Gu Xianglin, Dean of CCE and Prof. Chen Shiming, Secretary of CCE Party Committee.

First of all, Prof. Luo Lie, Vice Secretary of CCE Party Committee, and Ms. Zhang Yanli, Vice Secretary of CCE Party Committee, introduced the preparation work of the Centennial Celebration, the CCE Alumni Work and the CCE Fund. Then Prof. Li Jianzhong, Vice Dean of CCE, Prof. Zhao Xianzhong, Vice Dean of CCE, Prof. Ye Weimin, Prof. Liu Shuguang, Prof. Huang Maosong , Head of the Department of Geotechnical Engineering, delivered reports under the topic of Discipline Construction and Student Cultivation. Prof. Zhu Attended the CSIC Meeting at Cambridge as the Member of International Advisory Group



Prof Zhu Hehua, from the Department of Geotechnical Engineering, was invited as a member of International Advisory Group (IAG) to attend the review meeting held at the Centre for Smart Infrastructure and Construction in University of Cambridge (CSIC) from March 12 to 15, 2014. The group members attended include Prof. Yojo Fujino (University of Tokyo, Japan), Prof. Tom O'Rourke (Cornell University, the US), Prof. Spencer Billie (UIUC, the US) and Prof. Zhu (Tongji University, China). The another IAG member Prof. Wright (UC Berkeley, the US) was not able to come to the meeting. Prof. O'Rourke was appointed as the Chair of IAG. Dr. Schooling, the newly appointed head of the CSIC gave a speech reporting the progress of the research in the centre in the past year. In particular, he addressed the ten key problems raised up by IAG in its previous meeting (report dated January 23, 2013) and actions taken in response to the IAG comments. Phillip Keenan as Business Development Director and Helen Needham as Communications Manager are excellent additions to the management team. The IAG commends Jennifer Schooling, Center Director, for her outstanding grasp of center activities and contributions to the management team. A closed session was held involving representatives from industrial partners and infrastructure owner. The representatives expressed their opinions on the report and perspective of the center. A poster session was arranged afterwards demonstrating the progress and deliverables of the centre in the past year. In the session, the research staff discussed with the group members on the research outcome. A parallel session was also arranged for a presentation on recent advance in vibration generated power energy. The meeting was concluded by a brief discussion between the head of the centre and four of the group members.

The 2014 Joint Final Design Program for Undergraduate Students Launched in CCE



In order to promote the Elite Engineers Plan, CCE launched the Joint Final Design Program for Undergraduate Students with Taiwan University in 2011. In 2012, the Program expanded to Taiwan University, Cheng Kung University, Feng Chia University and Hong Kong Poly-Tech University(HKPU). In 2013, along with the Universities mentioned above, UPC from Spain and KAIST from Korea also joined this Program with CCE.

In 2014, totally 30 students participated in this program, including 10 students to Taiwan University, 11 students to Cheng Kung University, 4 students to Feng Chia University, 2 students to UPC and 3 students to KAIST. The 5 students who went to study in UPC and KAIST got the scholarship from the China Scholarship Council(CSC) and other students will be sponsored by CCE.

On March 7th,2013, the orientation meeting on 2014 Joint Final Program for undergraduate student was held in CCE. Prof. Huang Hongwei, Vice Dean of CCE, Ms.Tao Mingxia from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan Affairs Office and Ms. Shen Jiajun, Secretary of Foreign Affairs in College of Civil Engineer joined the meeting.

They are: CCE, TJU - Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) Joint Final Design Program (3 students), CCE, TJU -Universitat Politècnica De Catalunya(UPC) Joint Final Design Program(2 students) and CCE, TJU -National University of Singapore(NUS) Course Study Exchange Program(4 students).

In 2014, one more program: CCE, TJU -UPM Joint Final Design Program(3 students) is approved by CSC and the number of students for the KAIST and UPC programs are increased to 5 students respectively.

Dr. Zhang Chao Receives IAFSS Best Thesis Award

On Feb 13, 2014, Dr. Zhang Chao, alumnus of College of Civil Engineering of Tongji University, received the IAFSS Best Thesis Award on the 11th Conference of International Association for Fire Safety Science (IAFSS) at the University of Canterbury, New Zealand.

IAFSS is an international authority of Fire Safety. It holds the selection of IAFSS Best Ph.D. Thesis Award every three years and three researchers are awarded each time.

Dr. Zhang Chao did his Ph.D. work under the supervision of Prof. Li Guoqiang. Graduated with a Ph.D. degree in 2012, he joined the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) in the United States and became the first Guest Researcher at National Fire Research Laboratory of NIST.
